



Julian Webber

After qualifying from Birmingham Dental School, UK in 1974, Dr. Webber worked as an Associate in a National Health Service Practice for two years before continuing his education at Northwestern University Dental School, Chicago, Illinois, USA. As the recipient of the prestigious Charles Freeman Scholarship of the American Dental Society of Europe he was the first UK dentist to receive a Master of Science degree in Endodontics and returned to the UK in 1978.

From 1978 – 1983, Dr. Webber, held part-time teaching positions both at Guys Hospital and Eastman Dental Schools in London, UK and maintained a practice limited to Endodontics in central London.

He has practiced Endodontics in Central London exclusively since 1978 and devotes much time to teaching and writing having contributed to numerous journals and textbooks on Endodontics and extensively lectured around the world. His major lectures include the British Dental Association, the British Endodontic Society, The Irish Dental Association, the American Association of Endodontists, the Dutch Endodontic Society, The Belgian Dental Association, Arab Dentistry (Dubai) and the Portuguese Dental Association

Dr. Webber is a former President of the British Endodontic Society, a member of the American Association Endodontists, European Society of Endodontology and a member of both the American Dental Societies of London and Europe. He is a faculty member of the Pacific Endodontic Research Foundation in San Diego, California, USA where he has perfected and taught techniques on Microscope conventional and surgical Endodontics.

In 1998, he became Editor in Chief of **Endodontic Practice** journal, a clinical endodontic journal which has rapidly grown into a world leader in its field with a large circulation both in the UK and worldwide. He is also a clinical advisor to Independent Dentistry journal.

Dr. Webber's hugely successful lecture series "The Root to Success" which started in 1997 has been attended by nearly 2000 dentists in the UK and abroad in such places as Holland, Belgium, Portugal, Israel, Ireland and South Africa with plans to present

in the Far East and Australasia. All these courses have been followed up with Hands on days to over 500 participants so far.
