Dr. Juergen Manhart is currently Associate Professor in the Department of Restorative Dentistry, Periodontology and Pediatric Dentistry at the Dental School of the Ludwig-Maximilians-University (LMU) in Munich, Germany. He received his D.D.S. degree from LMU in 1994. He received the title Dr.med.dent. (Ph.D.) from LMU in 1997. Dr. Manhart completed a one-year post-doctoral research program as an Adjunct Assistant Professor in the Biomaterials Research Center, Department of Basic Sciences, University of Texas, Houston, USA. Dr. Manhart serves as a reviewer for several dental journals. He is a member of the German Institute for Standardization, Committee on Restorative Dental Materials (NADENT D1) and in several national and international scientific dental associations. In addition to his teaching and research responsibilities, Dr. Manhart is engaged in clinical dentistry in an intramural practice facility, focussing on general and aesthetic dentistry. Dr. Manhart has authored several book chapters and numerous research articles in national and international dental journals, focussing on clinical studies and *in vitro* testing of dental materials. He has given numerous lectures, continuing education courses, and Hands-on-courses on aesthetic dentistry in Germany, Austria, China, South Korea, Bulgaria, Liechtenstein, France, Italy, United States of America, United Kingdom, Canada, and Russia.
